Number of children (0-15 year olds) in pedestrian accidents in Dangershire

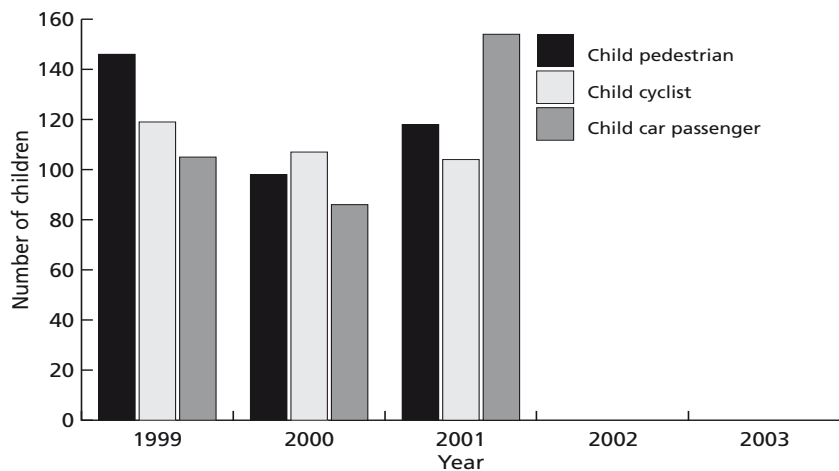
